Optional materials are marked with *

Acrylic paints: (colors that you'll need)

- cadmium red
- phthalo blue
- lemon yellow
- raw sienna
- burnt sienna
- burnt umber,
- alizarine red /or Quinacridone Rose /or Magenta
- phthalo green
- olive green / sap green / chrome oxide / Hooker's green
- titanium white
- ultramarine blue
- yellow ochre
- raw umber
- black
- ... any other colors that you like

Suggested affordable brands for paints:

Winsor & Newton Acrylics, Liquitex Basics Acrylic, Arteza (Amazon brand), store brands like Blick or Artist Loft.

Paintbrushes:

Basic set of synthetic paintbrushes, sizes from 2 to 8, 1-2 big flat brushes (size 10-16)

Painting surfaces of your choice:

canvases, canvas pads, watercolor paper, or other high-density paper (for acrylic or watercolors) . If you prefer working with paper, you may want to use a board and masking tape to stretch the paper on the board. Any sizes will be good.

Plastic palette and palette knives (may be plastic or metal)

Color wheel of any size

* **Board and masking tape** to stretch the paper

* **Tabletop easel** – You can paint flat, especially if using a board. However, painting on canvas usually requires an easel. There are cheap and lightweight tabletop easels that work perfectly.

* **Watercolor pencils** (soft core, e.g. Prismacolor) for sketching, correcting and work on details.

* **Color wheel**

* **Slow drying medium for acrylics** (e.g. Liquitex or Winsor&Newton), or water sprayer
